

# Class Action Notice:

*Maroney, et al. v. Woodstream Corporation, No. 19-cv-8294 (S.D.N.Y.)*

*Approved by the U.S. District Court*

Did you purchase a Victor PestChaser Rodent Repeller in the State of New York from August 29, 2013 until November 17, 2025?

There is a class action lawsuit that may affect your rights.

If you want to be part of the class action, you do not need to do anything. If not, you need to opt out postmarked by December 30, 2025.

## Important things to know:

- The purpose of this notice is to inform you that your rights may be affected in the future. The Court has not decided whether the Defendant has done anything wrong, as the Plaintiffs must prove their allegations of wrongdoing. The Defendant denies all allegations of wrongdoing and has asserted defenses to the Plaintiffs' claims.
- By doing nothing, you stay in the lawsuit and you keep the possibility of getting money or benefits that may come from a trial or a settlement. You will give up your right to sue the Defendant separately about the same legal claims in this lawsuit. You will be bound by any future judgment in this lawsuit, including if that judgment is that Defendant is not liable for any wrongdoing.
- If you do not want to stay in the lawsuit, you need to opt out **postmarked by December 30, 2025**. If you opt out and money or benefits are later awarded, you will not receive any money or benefits. You will keep any right to file your own lawsuit or be part of any other lawsuit against the Defendant at your own expense, and with your own lawyer about the same legal claims in this lawsuit.

# About This Notice

## Why did I get this notice?

This notice is to tell you about a class action lawsuit, *Maroney, et al. v. Woodstream Corporation*, Case No. 19-CV-8294, brought on behalf of individuals who bought a Victor-brand PestChaser Rodent Repeller in the state of New York.

The Defendant denies all allegations of wrongdoing, and the Court has not decided that Defendant did anything wrong. However, if you are a member of the class, your legal rights are affected and you have a choice to make now.

This notice gives you information about the lawsuit and tells you how to opt out if you do not want to be part of it. It is an important document, and it is recommended that you read all of it. ## What do I do next?

Read this notice to understand the lawsuit and to determine if you are a class member. Then, decide if you want to stay in the lawsuit or opt out.

# Learning About the Lawsuit

## What is this lawsuit about?

Beginning in 2019, a class action lawsuit was filed against Woodstream Corporation (“Defendant” or “Woodstream”). The lawsuit was brought by individuals (“Plaintiffs”) on behalf of consumers who bought a Victor-brand PestChaser in the state of New York. The lawsuit alleges that Woodstream’s PestChaser does not work as advertised.

The Defendant denies all allegations of wrongdoing and has asserted defenses against the Plaintiffs' claims.

### **Is there any money or benefits available now?**

No money or benefits are available now. The Court has not decided whether Defendant did anything wrong, and Plaintiffs and Defendant have not settled the lawsuit. There is no guarantee money or benefits will be obtained in the future. You will be notified if money or benefits become available.

### **Has the Court decided who is right?**

The Court has not decided whether the Plaintiffs or Defendant is right. The parties will have a chance to prove or disprove their legal claims and/or defenses. The Plaintiffs must prove their legal claims at a trial.

### **What Happens next in this lawsuit?**

Plaintiffs and Defendant will continue the lawsuit and prepare for trial, unless the Plaintiffs and Defendant decide to settle the lawsuit or the Court decides before trial or settlement that either the Plaintiffs or Defendant are correct as a matter of law.

## Who is in the Class

### **Who is in the class?**

You are in the class if you purchased a Victor PestChaser Rodent Repeller in the State of New York from August 29, 2013, until November 17, 2025.

### **What if I am still not sure I am in the class?**

## Do I have a lawyer in this lawsuit?

In a class action, the court appoints lawyers, also called Class Counsel, to work on the lawsuit and represent the interests of all the class members. For purposes of the lawsuit, the Court has appointed the following lawyers.

**Your lawyers:** Timothy G. Blood and James M. Davis of Blood Hurst & O'Reardon and Yitzchak Kopel and Stephen Beck of Bursor & Fisher P.A. These are the lawyers who are bringing the lawsuit on your behalf.

**You will not be charged for their services.** If Class Counsel gets money or benefits for the class, they may ask the Court for an award of attorneys' fees and expenses. If the Court grants Class Counsel's request, the attorneys' fees and expenses will either be deducted from any money obtained for the class or paid separately by the Defendant.

You do not need to hire your own lawyer, but if you want your own lawyer, you may hire one at your own expense.

## Deciding What to Do

### What are my options?

You have two options. You can do nothing and stay in the lawsuit, or you can opt out of the lawsuit.

## Doing Nothing and Staying in the Lawsuit

### What happens if I do nothing?

You do not have to do anything now if you want to keep the possibility of getting money or benefits from this lawsuit in the future.

If you do nothing, you will stay in the lawsuit, and if Plaintiffs obtain money or benefits in the future, you will be notified about how to get your share. If you do nothing now, you will not be able to start, continue, or be part of any other lawsuit against Defendant about the legal issues in this lawsuit. You will be legally bound by all orders and judgments.

If the Plaintiffs win or settle, class members may be entitled to money or benefits. If Defendant wins, class members will receive nothing.

## Opting Out

### What If I don't want to be part of this lawsuit?

You can opt out.

### Why would I want to opt out?

If you do not want to be part of the class for whatever reason, including because you want to sue the Defendant on your own regarding the same legal claims in this lawsuit, or you already have your own lawsuit against Defendant regarding the same legal claims in this lawsuit and you want to continue with it, you need to opt out of the class.

If you start your own lawsuit or continue with an existing lawsuit against Defendant regarding the same legal claims in this lawsuit after you exclude yourself, you will have to hire your own lawyer(s) for that lawsuit if you want counsel, and you will have to prove your legal claims.

### What happens if I opt out?

If you opt out from the class, you won't get any money or benefits if they become available in the future. You will not be bound by any judgments the Court makes in this lawsuit. By opting out, you will keep your right to sue the Defendant about the legal claims in this lawsuit at your own expense.

### How do I opt out?

To opt out of the lawsuit (sometimes called "excluding" yourself), you must send a written "Request for Exclusion" by mail. Your request must include the following:

- a) Your full name, address, telephone number, and email (if any);
- b) Why you believe you are a class member;
- c) Your personal physical signature; and

d) A clear statement that you want to be excluded from the class in *Maroney v. Woodstream*, Case No. 7:19-cv-08294.

If you send your request by mail, it must be **postmarked** by **December 30, 2025**, to the Notice Administrator at the following address:

**You cannot opt out online, by telephone or by email.**

“Mass or “class” requests for exclusion filed by third parties on behalf of a “mass” or “class” of class members or multiple class members where the opt out has not been signed by each and every individual class member will not be allowed.

## What is the deadline to opt out?

If you send your request by mail, it must be **postmarked** by **December 30, 2025**.

## What’s Next in the Litigation

### How and when will the Court decide who is right?

Over the coming months, Plaintiffs and/or Defendant may ask the Court to decide the claims or defenses in this case as a matter of law before proceeding to trial.

If the parties’ dispute is not resolved as a matter of law, Class Counsel will have to prove Plaintiffs’ legal claims at a trial. The trial has not been scheduled. During the trial, a Jury and the Judge will hear all of the evidence to help them reach a decision about whether Plaintiffs or Defendant are right about the legal claims in the lawsuit. There is no guarantee that the Plaintiffs will win, or that they will get any money for the class.

### Do I have to attend the trial?

No. You do not need to attend the trial. Class Counsel will present the case for the Plaintiffs and the class, and lawyers for Defendant will present on their behalf. You or your own lawyer may attend at your own expense.

## Will I get money after the trial?

If the Plaintiffs obtain money or benefits as a result of the lawsuit, and you remain in the class, you will be notified about how to participate to receive money or benefits. It is unknown whether this will happen or how long this will take.
